

SAFETY, PACE AND CARE OF THE GOLFCOURSE

COURSE PERSONNEL
Course Personnel always has priority over golfers

PACE OF PLAY
Please make sure that you keep the same pace as the group in front of you

BAG
Always put your bag in the direction of the following hole.

PRACTICE SWING
Make your practice swing outside of the Teebox without damaging the grass. Please be aware of other players when making your practice swing

PITCHMARKS
Please always repair your pitchmarks and if necessary those of others

RAKING BUNKERS
Rake the bunker after you have hit your stroke. Also rake all the footsteps even if they are not yours.

AFTER HOLING OUT
Leave the green immediately and note your score on the tee box of the next hole

FORE
Whenever FORE is being yelled by another player, please do not look around but immediately duck and cover for the incoming ball

DIVOT
Whenever you hit a divot, replace the divot and firmly press the divot into the ground with your foot.

3 MINUTE SEARCH
Hit your ball first and then aid your playing partners with the search. The limit of searching for a ball is 3 minutes, and if necessary let the group behind you go through,

BE AWARE
Never hit the ball when other players are in range of play

FORE
If your ball is travelling towards other players, please yell FORE

PICKING THE TEE
Pick the tee color that is suitable for your level.

USE OF PHONE
Don't call on the course, only in case of emergency

REPAIRING A PITCHMARK ON THE GREEN

Put the pitchfork close to the pitchmark in the ground

Move the pitchfork towards the pitchmark, allowing the ground to move sideways towards the pitchmark

Repeat the process from varying directions

Push the irregularities in the ground with your putter or foot

Don't repair the pitchmark by pulling the grass upwards, this will cause the roots to break

PLAYING PARTNERS
Please watch the shot of your playing partners so that you can see where the ball ends up. This will allow you to find the ball quicker
